Introduction

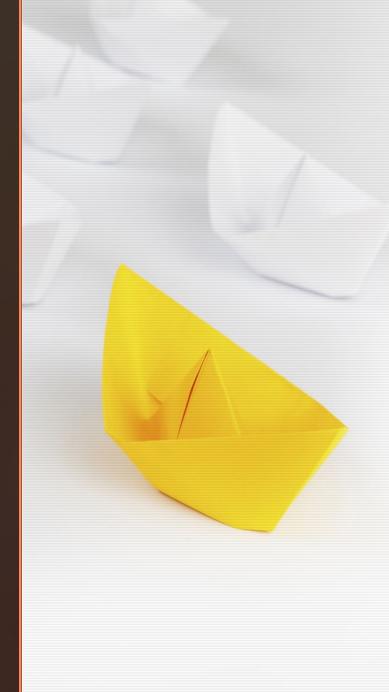
The purpose of this document is to provide guidance on how to introduce the audit team members effectively during a management system certification audit. The introduction is crucial for establishing a professional relationship with the auditee and clarifying roles and responsibilities. Compliance with ISO 17021-1:2015 is required.

Audit Team Members

- Audit team leader: Responsible for the audit's planning, conduct, and reporting.
- Audit team members: Assist the leader in audit activities.
- Observer: Accompanies the team without acting as an auditor.
- Translator: Provides oral translation without modifying information.
- Technical expert: Offers specific knowledge or expertise.
- Representative of the accreditation body: Monitors the certification body and audit team.

Importance of Effective Introduction

- Establishes credibility and professionalism.
- Builds trust and rapport with the auditee.
- Clarifies roles and responsibilities.
- Communicates the audit's scope, objectives, criteria, and methodology.
- Addresses questions or concerns.
- Sets the tone and expectations for the audit process.



Requirements of ISO 17021-1:2015

- Clause 9.4.2: Introduction of audit team members to the auditee's management.
- Clause 9.4.7.2: Ensure awareness of the audit objectives, scope, and criteria.
